Metal is a top choice in severe weather and climate conditions, including wildfire prone areas.

Not only do metal roof and wall panels last longer, they also require far less maintenance than other popular residential products.

For starters, advanced paint systems like our Kynar 500®/PVDF keep their shine and like new appearance for decades so you can pitch your painting gear!

Beyond holding their initial color and shine, metal panels are stronger and more durable, don't absorb water, and resist pests. The slick nature of metal also deters mold and mildew growth to offer improved health benefits.
